
Dear Parents:

The Lanett City School District continues to provide innovative programs and activities. W. O. Lance Elementary students enjoy art and music this year as well as a state-recognized gifted and enrichment program. Math remediation and protected reading time is also a part of daily instruction. Lanett Jr. High students, in addition to a required reading/composition course, can take new electives such as drama, journalism and computer applications. Lanett High students continue AP courses for eleventh and twelfth graders and a required JROTC class for ninth graders. The school's graduation coach continues one-on-one remediation in small group pull-out sessions.
